Trial begins after installation validation & education / training.

Clinician-Based Support Intervention

- Weekly remote clinical engagement
- · Mid-point on-site visit
 - Discuss barriers and challenges to hand hygiene
 - Continue workflow analysis
 - Complete just-in-time coaching
 - Focus on 5 approach: 5 RIGHTS OF HAND HYGIENE $^{\text{\tiny{M}}}$
