

4 Questions to Clean

Clean and disinfect safely and effectively by asking these simple questions.

What product do I choose?

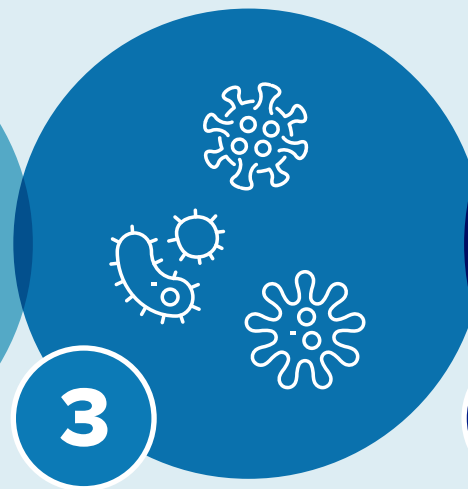
Surface products only work on surfaces. Hand products only work on hands. Be sure to choose the product that matches the job.

How do I use the product safely?

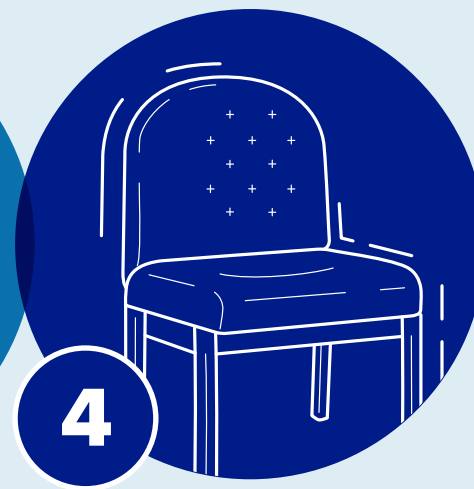
Some surface disinfectants come with hazard labels that begin with “CAUTION” or “WARNING.” Check the product label for these and follow use instructions carefully.

How do I make sure I'm killing germs?

A disinfectant kills germs when it is applied and remains *visibly wet* for a certain amount of time. The kill times, or dwell times, for various organisms will be listed on the label.

What are the most important areas to clean?

Surfaces and items that are touched by many different people should be disinfected periodically throughout the day, while surfaces and items that a single person touches can be disinfected just once a day. Remember to consider soft surfaces, like upholstered furniture.
