



BODY FLUID SPILL KIT

Training Guide



PREPARE



1 Empty all spill kit contents on a flat surface near spill.



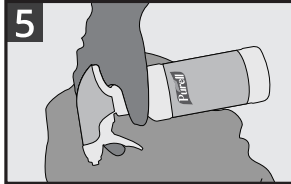
4 Affix mask then put on hair cover. Place gloves over hands and pull them up over the gown sleeves.



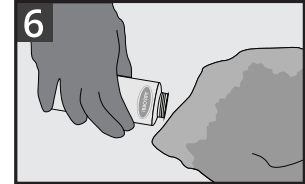
2 Open PPE pack and place shoe covers over shoes.



3 Put on gown using head and thumb loops. Tie behind back.

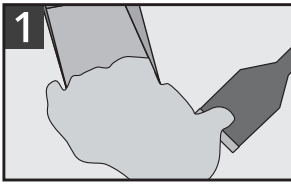


5 Spray spill and surrounding area with the enclosed bottle of PURELL® Foodservice Surface Sanitizer.

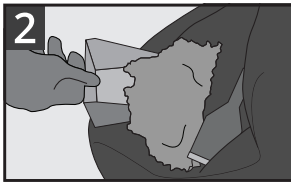


6 Wait 30 seconds. Sprinkle absorbent powder over entire spill site.

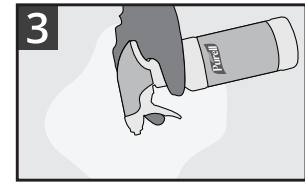
CLEAN AREA



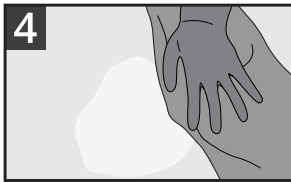
1 Once the spill is solid, use the dust pan and scraper to scoop it up.



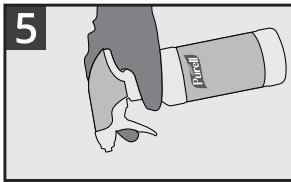
2 Place all solid waste, dust pan and scraper in first black trash bag.



3 Thoroughly respray entire spill site. Wait 30 seconds.

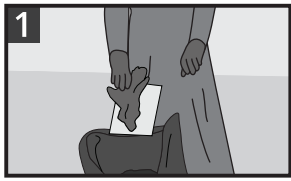


4 Use absorbent towels to wipe spill site and deposit in black bag.



5 Spray all remaining sanitizer over spill site and allow site to air dry. Place empty bottle in the trash bag.

FINISH



1 Put any remaining kit items in first trash bag and use drawstring to seal shut. Place first trash bag in second trash bag.



2 Remove shoe covers. Remove mask and hair cover. Discard in the second trash bag. Next, grasp the front of the gown with both hands.



3 Pull both hands forward, away from the body, to break the gown neck loop and back ties. Discard in second bag.



4 Use the inside sleeves of the gown to remove gloves without contacting the contaminated side. Discard in second bag.



5 Seal second bag with drawstring and dispose in outside dumpster. Immediately use PURELL SINGLES™ Hand Sanitizer. Once back inside, wash hands thoroughly for 20 seconds.
